- Teachers are beginning to work in PLC groups to determine goals and strategies/activities to help with student achievement. Good conversations during staff meetings.
- d. Budget/FinanceReport: Review August & when we get September will review
  - August Annual Fund raising budget raised-raised-where is that money coming from? Talent show goes in there (fund raising that happens at the school-band concerts, Talent Show)
  - Tuition high over the budget (some parents pay in for all of the year) watch the Annual to date
  - Registration Fees? Year to date have not brought in what was anticipated for registration fees. We brought more kids so would think be over from a annual perspective? For a year to date that is like a 5000.00 underage that is a kid. would have to figure out where the shortage is.
  - Custodial workers had a huge jump there- is that tied to the roof leaking, dishwasher being broken? These are August financial's
  - Technology-hardware- is that for the chrome books? Will find out and get back on this.
  - Child Care Providers more kids over the summer is that why will find out
  - Ordinary Repairs seems to up also, dishwasher would be shared with the parish and the roof – parish and would not be in this budget
  - Is the 250,000 difference being that the parish contribution? Yes, that is the subsidy from the parish over school.
  - Jennifer will report back on questions
  - Depreciation expense- used as a replacement- depreciate items out so we have money to replace it with. This money gets set aside. (Like a savings bank)

Electric sign out, would have to have a plan, there is a parishioner that has a radio station (Spanish) and they are totally booked with CTK.
