- Lemonade and cookies were nice in the cafeteria during the Book Fair, only one complaint-lunch staff wouldn't let a grandma grab her own cookie.
- Book Fair: Huge success! Best one SAS has ever had. Will make a change for the cash registers so line is not blocking books. Students helped (Those without a visitor for the event) Already used \$1200.00 earned from that to purchase books for the future K-2 literacy night. And we purchased during Scholastic's BOGO free, so we were able to get \$2400 worth of books.

- Safety and Security walk through Jen met with and walked through the whole school plus with a team of safety and security people to plan of current needed fixes, future changes (big and small)
- Music and Band performances overall very well done and successful Jen and Kolbo and Gerais have met and discussed some tweaks for next time and the great things already happening
- Our Lady of Guadalupe was a success during the 2 performances. Monsignor suggested that we consider an English narration or saying some lines in English after they're said in Spanish, so all audience members know what's going on.

- c. Budget/Finance Overview Report: Questions that were asked and answered from August financials emailed out

- Fund raising budget raised-where is that money coming from? Talent show goes in there (fund raising that happens at the school-band concerts, Talent show) see financials. We do not raise funds at school band concerts. Mark does not know info on that.
- Tuition high over the budget? Some parents pay in for all the year watch the Annual to date
- Registration Fees? Year to date have not brought in what was anticipated for registration fees. We brought more kids so would think be over from a annual perspective? For a year to date that is like a 5000.00 underage that is a kid-would have to figure out were the shortage is We have \$1600 in delinquent as of right after Thanksgiving. We have \$4700. That never came in last year. Registration billed but not collected we bill this year's Registration fees last year and it goes into savings until July 1, then goes into current budget less \$4700
- Custodial workers had a huge jump (abnormal summer, lots of transition work, more time spent than was budgeted) there- is that tied to the roof leaking (not labor related), dishwasher being broken (not labor related) These are August Financial's
- Technology hardware- is that for the chrome books? NO, projector bulbs, printers & hard drive
- Child Care Providers more kids over the summer is that why? vacation pay for 3 weeks, otherwise Adv Club monthly #'s within about \$30. Labor this summer was higher under Mayra.
- Ordinary Repairs dishwasher (school side) would be shared with the parish and the roof (church side) parish and would not be in this budget
- Is the 250,00 difference being that the parish contribution? Yes, that is the subsidy from the Paris over school
- Depreciation expense? Used as a replacement depreciate items out so we have money to replace it with. This money gets set aside. (like a savings bank)
- Thanksgiving time we had \$21,00 in uncollected tuition People not paying is really hurting 2 families leave, letters will be going out.
- Generalization: pass basket at church, pay church bills, give to school what's left
- For every \$1.00 one of us (Parish or School) overspends somewhere- must find that
