- Last month the BOE asked Kari Howard what are some things that we can do to help retain teachers. We fully understand that teachers are underpaid and are working to increase pay, unfortunately, this takes time and extra resources. However, there are things that they can work to make happen now. Kari sent a survey out to our teachers. Here are some items that we as a community can do to help now.
- Extra personal days
- Technology
- Paid maternity leave, provide mentors for new teachers, incentivize continuing education.
- Increase salary, sponsor teachers for Spanish immersion program, scholarship (or at least a good discount) for teacher's children that want to work or are working here.
- More health benefits.
- ½ personal day on birthday or close to it
- Continuing education money
- Catch up day
- Recognize their good work when they do it not only telling them what they need to improve
- For the Spanish speaking teachers who needs a visa to stay help them with that.
- Need a Religion teacher for middle school.
- Need better tech support for both students and teachers
- Mentor program
- Buy back unused sick days and or personal days at the end of the school year.
- At Christmas give \$100 cash to each classroom teacher for reimbursements and buy supplies for the school year.
