Our Summer Program:

We offer two summer programs. Our first program is an early childhood program offered to ages 3 & 4. Our second program is for school age children ages 5-12. Both programs are filled with fun activities and learning opportunities for children of all ages.

Early Childhood Program (Ages 3-4):

Our early childhood summer program is only for children ages 3-4 who are fully toilet trained. This program will stay on site Monday through Friday as they are not allowed to travel by bus. Our early childhood children will participate in the following activities:

- Outdoor Play
- Physical activities in our gymnasium
- Crafts
- Water Play/Splash Pad (Wednesdays)
- Movie Days
- Kona Ice
- Letter, Numbers, Shapes, Colors
- Name Writing
- Dress Up Days

School Age Summer Program (Ages 5-12):

We also offer a school age summer program for children ages 5 to 12. This program will go on field trips and to the pool weekly. Our school age children will participate in the following activities:

- Outdoor Play
- Physical activities in our gymnasium
- Crafts
- Pool (Tuesdays)
- Field Trips (Thursdays)
- Learning activities
- Movie Days
- Kona Ice
- Dress Up Days

Capacity/Waiting List:

A waiting list will be established once we hit our capacity. Our capacity is thirty-five school age children and ten 3 & 4 year old's. The students who are enrolled in St. Anthony Plus during this school year will receive priority. If your child turns four before June 1^{st} and there is room in the school age group, there is a possibility that we may move them up if numbers allow. Registration information must be turned in by April 26^{th} 2022.

Drop off & Pick-Up:

Our facility is located in the lower church and our doors will remain locked during all hours of operation. When you arrive to drop off or pick up please call (515)-380-5515. If we are ever on the playground or gym when you arrive, we will let you know when you call. If you would like to pick up your child from a field trip, please arrange plans with the director.

To ensure the safety of your child and all of the other children, once you arrive to drop off or pick up your child you assume full responsibility for your child while you are in our facility. St. Anthony summer staff will then assume full responsibility once the parent or guardian has left our facility.

Late Fee:

Please remember to be on time when picking up your child at the end of the day. There will be a \$5.00 per minute late charge for picking up your child after 5:30. There will be no warnings or grace times. Frequent late pickups could result in the loss of your childcare spot. If more than 15 minutes have passed and we have not heard from you, and we are not able to reach you or your other emergency contacts then we will contact the local police.

Meals:

Breakfast and snack are included in your monthly fee. Each morning breakfast is served beginning at 8:00 AM until 8:30 AM. We will have lunch in the afternoon around 11:00. You are responsible to pack your child a cold lunch every day! Snack will be served from 3:20 PM until 3:45 PM. Lunch and snack times may vary with field trips.

Medications:

We can administer prescription medication to your child(ren) in agreement with a signed medication form. Over the counter medication can only be given if prescribed by a doctor, A written, and signed authorization is required. Medication needs to be in the original container and clearly labeled with the child's name, name of medication, dosage, and instructions for administration and storage.

Notification of Absence:

NO Toys or Items Brought From Home:

We do not allow children to bring DS's Game Boys, MP3 players, IPods, or other items from home because St. Anthony will not be held responsible for lost, broken, or stolen toys and games. We have plenty of toys and games for children to play while in our care.

Health:

The Department of Human Services requires all parents to provide an updated copy of your child's immunization record and current physical *prior* to starting the early childhood summer program. A physical and immunization form is not required for school age children. In the best interest of your child(ren) and others, DHS requires the children to remain at home if they have the following symptoms:

- Temperature over 100 degrees
- Rashes that you cannot identify or that have not been diagnosed by a doctor
- Diarrhea or Vomiting
- Discharge or redness in the eyes
- Severe cold symptoms; sneezing, runny nose, fever, cough, lack of energy
- A contagious condition as diagnosed by the doctor
- Head Lice We will send the child home until it is treated, and no nits are present
- Children need to be symptom free for at least 24 hours before they can return to or program.

Discipline Policy

If a child for any reason is not following the rules, an SAS staff member will discipline your child in a manner that they feel is appropriate for your child. Depending on the severity of the offense a written notice may be sent home with your child. Your child will be given 3 written notices home, after the third notice the St. Anthony Director will hold a parent meeting to come up with a plan of action to correct the behavior. If the behavior continues the child will then be excused from St. Anthony Summer Program for three days. After a suspension if the behavior continues the child will then be asked to leave the St. Anthony Summer program. Overly offensive, abusive, disruptive behavior will result in an immediate suspension.

Toilet Training:

Your child must be potty trained if they are in our care. We will allow accidents to happen as children learn to adjust to our school and schedule but if the accidents continue, the child may be removed from our care until they are officially potty trained. Please pack an extra outfit in your child's bag in case of an accident. If we go through the outfit you provided and they have another accident you will be required to pick them up. We do not have the staff or toilet locations to be toilet training children a majority of our day.

Clothing/Shoes:

Children may wear clothing they are comfortable in. If girls wear dresses, we ask that they wear shorts underneath. We ask that you do not let your child wear flip flops as we will be outside or in the gym running and we want to avoid injuries. If we go to the pool, we suggest wearing swim shoes rather than sandals.

Supply List:

Each child must have the following provided from home and everything MUST be labeled.

- 2 SPRAY bottles of sunscreen AND 1 face stick (will be asked to bring more later)
- Refillable Water Bottle
- Extra set of clothing
- Sack lunch everyday
- Beach towel, swimsuit, and pool shoes on water days
- Needed Medications
- Special Snacks due to Allergies

Payment Guidelines:

All monthly fees are due each month. You will be billed in three monthly increments for the summer (June-August). All Payments will be made through **FACTS Tuition**. You will be billed for the entire amount, no matter how many days your child attends. If at any time your account falls more than 90 days behind, we will ask your child to be removed from St. Anthony Summer Program until your account is brought to current. Failure to pay will result in your child being removed permanently from our program.

Notice to Withdrawal:

If a child is enrolled after the 15th of the month, the tuition is one-half the monthly fee. For a child is enrolled before the 15th of the month, tuition for the month will be the full monthly fee. If a child is withdrawn before the 15th of the month with a two-week notice, tuition will be one-half the monthly fee. If a child is withdrawn after the 15th of the month, the tuition will be the full month's fee. Without a two week notice any withdrawal after the 15th of the month, the student's family will be responsible for half of the next month's tuition. This allows SAS to maintain operation and budgetary needs. Tuition rates are reviewed yearly. Tuition is an annual fee that is divided into equal monthly payments. The tuition rate is a set fee no matter how many days a student attends each month.
